


The Young Family, Missionaries to the People of Honduras



Many missionaries in Honduras have focused primarily on the two largest cities, Tegucigalpa (the Capitol), and San Pedro Sula. The country, however, is filled with thousands of smaller villages throughout the mountains, where many of the people rarely travel far from their homes. These villages have no gospel witness and the

harvest is truly plenteous. Our long-term goal is to plant indigenous Baptist churches in these villages.
